- Q9** *Fires and fire extinguishers are classified as Class A–D, F. Briefly outline the characteristics of each Class. What has happened to Class E?. What colour are the fire extinguishers for each Class?*
- Q10** *What are the six main factors to be considered when assessing a building with regard to means of escape in the case of fire?*
- Q11** *What is the purpose of emergency lighting?*
- Q12** *In the UK, fire legislation may be very broadly identified under two main categories - what are they?*
- Q13** *Outline the main requirements of The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 with regard to fire escape.*
- Q14** *Sketch a diagram of a fire notice.*
- Q15** *Briefly outline the factors that may be involved in causing a dust explosion; what measures may be taken to minimise the risk of such explosions?*
- Q16** *Outline five or six key factors in the prevention of liquid fires.*
- Q17** *Ditto the prevention of fires involving flammable gases.*
- Q18** *The HSE leaflet INDG227 Safe working with flammable substances uses the memory aid V ... I ... C ... E ... S ... please explain.*
